

Louise Gubbels, 81

July 30, 1920 – Nov. 22, 2001

ATLANTIC – Louise Katherine Gubbels, daughter of Bert Lafayette and Christina Cecilia Kurtenbach Scarlett, was born July 30, 1920, in Adair County and graduated from the Guthrie Center High School in 1938. Following high school, she was a secretary for an attorney in Guthrie Center for a couple of years before moving to Omaha and then to California.

Before coming to Atlantic, she married Willis Charles Henderson. He died March 12, 1948. She worked at Coast-to-Coast in Atlantic.

She married Victor Gubbels Aug. 16, 1958, in Atlantic. She was a member of S.S. Peter and Paul Catholic Church. She died Nov. 22, 2001, at the Atlantic Nursing & Rehab Center at age 81.

She was preceded in death by her parents; one brother, Paul Scarlett; her first husband, Willis Henderson; and a son-in-law, Ernest Talarico. Surviving are her husband, Victor B.
