**WESTPHALIA** — Agnes M. Wageman Goetzinger, daughter of Charles and Barbara (Schechinger) Wageman, was born January 2, 1926 in Westphalia. She was baptized and confirmed at St. Boniface Catholic Church in Westphalia. She attended grade school and high school at St. Boniface Catholic School, where she graduated with the class of 1943.
