She lived for a brief while at Peace Haven in Walnut and became a resident of Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in Elk Horn on October 6, 2011. It was there that she died on Tuesday, May 27, 2014 having attained the age of eighty-six years, seven months, and twenty-five days.

Lois was preceded in death by her parents, husband, daughter Brenda, sister Hazel Kjer, and brothers Woodrow and Wilfred Jensen.
