

## Warren Dagnas Hansen, 80 ✓

*Dec. 5, 1920 – Dec. 16, 2000*

**IRWIN** – Warren Dagnas Hansen, son of John D. and Petrenia (Petersen) Hansen, was born Dec. 5, 1920, in Jefferson Township, Shelby County. He attended Jefferson #7 country school through the eighth grade, and then worked for area farmers. He served in the Navy during World War II, entering the service Sept. 4, 1942. He fought in the Asian and European Theaters from the USS Wisconsin until his discharge Dec. 19, 1945.

He married Velma Lena Dalldorf July 17, 1953, in Denison. He continued to farm until his 1966 retirement. He was later employed by Robinson Implement in Irwin, and Talbot-Carlson Manufacturing, Inc., in Audubon. Velma died Aug. 16, 1991, in Manning. Warren continued living in Irwin until September, 1998, when he became a resident of the Manilla Manor in Manilla. He was a member of the United Methodist Church in Irwin. He was a life member of the Austin Earl Hiatt A.L. Post #614 in Irwin, and the VFW Post #3517 in Manning. He died Dec. 16, 2000, at the Manning Regional Healthcare Center at age 80 years and 11 days.

Preceding him in death were his parents; his wife, Velma; and two brothers, Albert Hansen and one in infancy. Survivors include one stepson, Bill (Caryl) McMahon of Irwin; three step grandchildren; four step great grandchildren and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Dec. 19, 2000, at the Irwin Methodist Church with Rev. Joseph P. Boysen officiating. Casket bearers were Mike Smith, Orrin Bruhn, Lyle Campbell, Steve Gawley, Randy Birks and Vernon Campbell. Burial was in the Oak Hill Cemetery in Irwin.
