Elliot retired in 1975 from Clarkson Hospital in Omaha, NE. He



was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Harlan. He died July 1, 2006, at Little Flower Haven Nursing and Rehabilitation Center at age 87 years, 10 months, and six days.
