He grew to adulthood in that community, and he attended St. Joseph's Catholic School In Dunlap, and was a member of the graduating class of 1939. Upon receiving his education, he began helping farm on his uncle's farm for several years.

Hart Assembly, Knights of Columbus and its Chalice Club. He participated in hand corn picking contests. He died May 12, 2006, at the Manilla Manor at age 85 years and nine days.

In addition to his parents, and his wife, Julia, Irvin was preceded in death by a son, John, a grandson, Joshua Heller, and his brothers and sisters, Leonard, Leo, Albert, Joseph, Lawrence, and Urban Heller.
