

Yvonne Holdsworth, 93

Feb. 3, 1922 - May 14, 2015

MANILLA — Yvonne, daughter of Dale and Bes-sie (Brogden) Cose, was born February 3, 1922, at Deloit. She graduated from Deloit High School and went on to work as a clerk at Farner's Clothing Store in Denison for several years.

September 1, 1947, Yvonne was united in marriage with Harold J. Holdsworth at Deloit. They lived on a farm east of Manilla where Yvonne was a busy farm wife, and they moved to Manilla in 1986. Yvonne was a member of the Community of



Christ Church in Denison. She was involved in Eastern Star for over 60 years and was an American Legion Auxiliary past president. Yvonne was active in the Jefferson Community Club and the Manilla Manor nursing home Board of Directors. She was also an accomplished seamstress. Harold died in 1995 and Yvonne continued to live in her home in Manilla. She had made plans to move to the nursing home however she died peacefully at her home on Thursday, May 14, 2015. Yvonne was 93 years, 3 months and 11 days of age.
