WALNUT – Senta Holst was born in Grand Island, NE, March 2, 1907, the daughter of Henry and Selma Krohn. She taught country school until she married.

She married Harry J. Holst and moved to Walnut and later to Griswold where they resided until his death. She became the Kappa Kappa Gamma housemother of Drake University. The students loved her and were privileged to have her presence on campus for nine years. She retired to her former hometown of Walnut. The years in her home just off main street were followed by a residence at Peace Haven. Senta moved to the Avoca Nursing Home where she died April 19, 2003, at age 96.

She is survived by a son, Gaylan H. Holst of Griswold; a daughter, Sherry Koch of Cumming; six grandchildren; 10 great grandchildren and other relatives.

Memorial services were held April 22, 2003, at the Pauley Knutson Funeral Home. Inurnment was in the Shelby Cemetery.
