HARLAN – Mildred Isobell Hull was born to George and Hester (Hewitt) Darnell Sept. 9, 1916, in Spencer, NE. She was baptized in Winnetoon, NE, and attended school there.

Oct. 6, 1933, Mildred married Charles Beran. To this union one daughter was born.

Mildred married Harold Hull June 15, 1943. Harold had two children. Four children were born to Harold and Mildred. Following their wedding, Mildred assisted Harold in their farming operations in Nebraska and later, in Iowa.
