GRETNA, NE — Claude Franklin Havick, Jr. was born on July 28, 1944 in Harlan, to Claude F. Havick, Sr. and Inez (Stephenson) Havick. Claude graduated from Maple Valley Community High School in 1962 and went on to graduate from Iowa State University with a Bachelor of Science Degree in 1969.
