She moved to Little Flower Haven in Earling for a while and in 2013, moved into Elm Crest Retirement Home. Marie died on Wednesday, September 16, 2015 at Myrtue Medical Center in Harlan at the age of eighty-five years, five months, and fourteen days.

Marie was preceded in death by her parents, husband Sylvan Jans, grandson Joe Kramer, Jr., brothers: Melvin, Donald, and Joe Bissen, and sisters Sr. Leona Bissen and Rita Benjamin.
