

After graduating from Kirkman High School in 1936, she attended summer school in Cedar Falls, to obtain her teaching certificate. She then taught country school north of Irwin, for four years.

June 3, 1941, Bernice married Keith Deen Johnson in Omaha, NE. The couple lived in California during World War II; they returned to Harlan in 1954. Bernice again taught school, first in rural schools and then at Laurel School in Harlan. She earned her Bachelor's Degree from Drake University
