

## Maxine Lawlor, 70

*Feb. 28, 1934 - Dec. 14, 2004*

**GRANITE FALLS, NC** — Maxine Errett Lawlor was born Feb. 28, 1934, in Shelby County, to the late George and Lucille Olson Errett. Maxine graduated from Harlan High School in 1953 and received her teaching certificate from Iowa State Teachers College in Cedar Falls in 1955. She then taught school in Irwin and Harlan. In 1961, she earned her BA degree from Drake University and taught school in Martinez, CA.

She married John Lawlor in Belle Plaine, Feb. 23, 1963, and taught school there for several years. She was a breast cancer survivor for 14 years. She died Dec. 14, 2004, at Caldwell County Hospice at age 70.
