BAY MINETTE, AL — Merle Victor Lechtenberger, Sr. was born Dec. 6, 1917, near Daykin, NE, the third child of Clara (Jordan) and Adolph O Lechtenberger. He grew up in Nebraska working with his parents and for neighbors. He helped at the Lechtenberger Family Dairy in Geneva, NE. While on military leave in 1941 he met Vesper Farrens.

Merle married Vesper in San Antonio, TX, June 16, 1942. He was a mechanic in the Army Air Corp. He farmed in Nebraska. When he moved to Alabama in the late 50's he worked for Woodhaven Dairy, Fairhope Dairy and Barbers. When he moved back to lowa he had the franchise for Prairie Farms Dairy in Fontanelle. When Merle retired in 1977 he and Vesper would spend the winters in Alabama and summers at their home in Hancock. In 1993 they made their home permanently in Bay Minette, AL. Merle dedicated himself to his creator and was baptized in 2004 as one of Jehovah's Witnesses. He died April 12, 2006 at his home at age 88.
