HARLAN - Glenavene Pearl Lee, daughter of Ray X. and Maymie Paralee (Lindsey) Williams, was born Oct. 11, 1920, in Wright Township Pottawattamie County. She was baptized and confirmed at the Christian Church in Oakland. She attended Lewis School and graduated in 1938. She married Kenneth "Bob" Benjamin Lee, Dec. 28, 1939, in Co. Bluffs. Three children were born to this union, Pat, Donna and Margaret. After their marriage, they joined the Altamont Baptist Church. They farmed for many years. They retired from farming in 1985, but remained on the farm, spending their winters in Apache Junction, AZ. She died April 12, 1998, at age 77 years, six months and one day.
