After her husband's death in 1980, Rita moved from the farm to Ports-

mouth, trading houses with her son Marvin and his family in 1983. Rita died on Sunday, December 14, 2014 at the Rose Vista Nursing Home in Woodbine, having attained the age of ninety-two years, four months, and two

days.
