LOGAN — Ivan "Ike" Earl Leonard was born Nov. 13, 1924, to Earl and Wilma (Gunnette) Leonard in Logan. Ike was raised in Logan and graduated from Logan High School.

Ike married Zola Beth Barnett Dec. 8, 1948, in Council Bluffs at Zoe's aunt's house. The couple farmed in Harrison County. He served on the Woodbine school board, ASC, and for 20 years he was a hail crop adjuster. He also served as a Harrison County Supervisor for 14 years and was active in the Democratic party. Ike was a member of the Logan Masonic Lodge, the Missouri Valley Triune Masonic Lodge, the Tangier Shriners, and the Woodbine United Methodist Church. He died at his home Sept. 15, 2005, at age 80 years, 10 months, and two days.
