

## Margaret Yunck Manley, 81

April 12, 1916 - Jan. 27, 1998

**TULSA, OK** - Margaret Mary Graif was born April 12, 1916, in Portsmouth, daughter of Joseph and Margaret Kavanaugh Yunck. She graduated from St. Mary's High School, Portsmouth, in 1934. She received an Associates Degree at Mount St. Scholastic College in Atchison, KS.

She married William F. Graif Dec. 28, 1938, in Sioux City. He died September 1951. In 1960 she married Fritz S. Manley in Tulsa, OK. He died in February 1983. Margaret worked as a school teacher and librarian.
