## **Hertha Moore, 84**

*Oct. 6, 1916 – May 20, 2001*

**NEWTON** – Hertha Irene Moore, daughter of Frank and Grace McCord Perry, was born Oct. 6, 1916, in Manilla. She graduated from Manilla High School in 1934, and later from the Omaha Beauty School. For a time she and her husband ran a beauty shop in Sidney. She was a longtime resident of the Newton area and a member of the United Methodist Church. She was employed by Dunlap Manufacturing Company in Newton.

Feb. 28, 1939, she married John Paul Moore in Council Bluffs. She died May 20, 2001, at age 84 years at Mercy Hospital Medical Center in Des Moines.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, and her brother, Frank M. Perry. She is survived by three sons and daughters-in-law, Ivan and Donna Moore of Story City; Larry and Deanna Moore of Minnetonka, MN and Samuel and Cindy Moore of Newton; 12 grandchildren; eight great grandchildren; a sister-in-law, Alma Perry of Manilla; and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at the Dence Funeral Home in Newton, May 24, 2001, conducted by Rev. Lester Moore, the brother of her late husband.
