Pauline's most cherished accomplishment was her family. She was extremely proud of her five children, eight grandchildren and her new great-grandson, all who affectionately call her "Polly." She loved phoning and emailing her kids to keep track of all their activities. Pauline was reborn to eternal life May 27, 2011 at the Israel Family Hospice House in Ames after a three-year battle with breast cancer having attained the age of eighty-six years, one month and twenty-four days.

In addition to her parents, Pauline was preceded in death by her husband Ken, and her son Steve.
