

## Beatrice Mutum, 69 ✓

*Oct. 18, 1929 - Jan. 12, 1999*

**WALNUT** - Beatrice Marion Mutum was born Oct. 18, 1929, in Co. Bluffs, the daughter of Philip and Thelma Shea Dinovo. She was one of two children in the family. She attended school in Co. Bluffs, and graduated from St. Albert's High School in 1946.

She married David Mutum July 14, 1952, in Co. Bluffs. They were the parents of one daughter, Dawn. She was a Girl Scout leader for 25 years and was a past member of the Board of Directors for the Nishnabotna Girl Scout Council. She operated the concessions at Prairie Rose State Park for 15 years. Since 1988, she has been the owner and operator of the Danish Bakery in Elk Horn. She was a member of the Monroe Methodist Church of rural Walnut. She died Jan. 12, 1999, at the Audubon County Memorial Hospital at age 69 years, two months and 25 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents. She is survived by her husband, David of Elk Horn; their daughter, Dawn Winder (Mike) of Rawlins, WY; one brother, John Dinovo of El Paso, TX; two grandchildren and other relatives.
