

Jean Myers, 71

Jan. 7, 1929 – Dec. 30, 2000

WALNUT – Jean Marie Myers was born Jan. 7, 1929, near Belgrade, in Nance County, NE. She was the daughter of John and Frances Bridgland Horacek and was one of two children in the family. She attended school in rural Nance County, NE, and the Fullerton High School.

She married Louis Myers May 24, 1948, in Grand Island, NE. They lived all their married lives in Walnut. During that time they were the parents of two children, Gloria and Ed.
