**PORTSMOUTH** - Patrick James Newland, son of James and Catherine (White) Newland, was born near Missouri Valley in Harrison County, Oct. 9, 1911. He attended country school near Dunlap, and grew to adulthood near there.

April 19, 1939, he married Barbara Arkfeld at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Panama. To this union seven children were born. They lived for many years on their farm south of Portsmouth. Along with farming, he also hauled and sold corn cobs. In later years, buying old machinery and fixing it up for resale was an enjoyable project for him. He loved his horses and rodeos.
