

## Milo Nordby, 74

*June 22, 1930 - March 12, 2005*

**KIMBALLTON** — Milo Dean Nordby, son of Reinhard and Lilly Larson Nordby, was born June 22, 1930, on a farm near Irwin. He was baptized and confirmed at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Irwin. Milo attended country school in the Irwin area while continuing to farm.

Dec. 19, 1951, Milo married Delores Petersen at the Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Jacksonville. From this union three daughters were born, Pam, Patty, and Penny. Milo and Delores farmed near the Irwin, Harlan, and Jacksonville areas until 1985. From 1985 to 2004, Milo was employed at the Harlan Golf and Country Club. He was a member of the Bethlehem Lutheran Church. He died March 12, 2005, at the Salem Lutheran Home at age 74 years, eight months, and 20 days.

In addition to his parents, Milo was preceded in death by his daughter, Penny; two brothers, Marvin and Vernan; and a sister, Igleedtis Nordby.
