

Annie C. Oloff, 76

Oct. 10, 1920 - July 23, 1997

WITTMANN, AZ - Annie C. Oloff was born Oct. 10, 1920 in Etna, PA, daughter of John and Mary Vulokovich, the eldest of five children. She graduated from Etna High School. In World War II she joined the Army Air Corps, serving as an aircraft mechanic and a Red Cross volunteer.

While stationed at Williams Field in Arizona, she met and married George D. Oloff Oct. 20, 1945 in Phoenix. After spending time in the service, they moved to a farm near Woodbine. In 1960, they again moved back to Arizona and operated a business which their son, Larry, still operates. She died July 23, 1997 at age 76. She was a member of Legion Post 29 in Glendale, AZ.

She was preceded in death by her husband in Jan. 1997, and daughter, Marilee Sept. 1993. Survivors are Jerry (Diane) Oloff of Twin Falls, ID; George Jr. (Marilyn) Oloff and Larry Oloff of Wittmann, AZ and eight grandchildren; in-laws, Vern and Lois Oloff, Maxine Oloff; nieces and nephews.

Funeral services were held July 26, 1997, at St. Anthony's of Padua Catholic Church in Wickenburg, AZ. Father John Vogt officiated and the American Legion Post 29 of Glendale, AZ had graveside military services at the Wickenburg Cemetery.
