## Clara B. Pfeifer, 94

**SPALDING, NE.** - Clara Barbara Pfeifer was born Aug. 11, 1895 on a farm northwest of Spalding, daughter of Joseph and Agnes (Glaser) Weber. She received her education in the Spalding area.

She married Leopold Joseph Pfeifer, Sept. 23, 1913, at St. Michael's Church in Spalding. The couple farmed in Wheeler Co., all their lives on the homestead presently owned by their youngest son, George. Her husband died, of a massive heart attack May 13, 1964, less than a year after they had celebrated their Golden Anniversary. She then moved into her home in Spalding. She was a member of St. Michael's Church and the Altar Society. She died Oct. 23, 1989 in the Boone County Hospital at age 94.

Survivors include two sons, Edwin of Denver and George of Spalding; five daughters, Mrs Leonard (Agatha) Hinkle of Spalding, Mrs Verdine (Mary Ann) Ede of Davenport; Mrs Harley (Teresa) Kruse of Harlan; Mrs Junior (Carol) Kershaw of Spalding

and Mrs Norman (Clara) Smith of Ericson, NE.; a brother, Vincent of Spalding and a sister, Nora Golden of CA.; 63 grandchildren; 133 great-grandchildren and 23 great-great grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her husband and parents, four sons, Bernard, Ambrose, Frank and Leo, Jr.; two infant sons and one grandchild, Tim Pfeifer.

Funeral services were held at St. Michael's Catholic Church, Spalding, NE with Fr. Robert Foster, officiating.
