

Harold Stanley Peterson, 82

Sept. 6, 1916 - Feb. 22, 1999

STOUGHTON, WI - Harold Stanley Peterson was born Sept. 6, 1916, in Badger.

He married Marjorie Lekwa Sept. 6, 1947 in Fort Dodge. They lived in the Roelyn area from 1947 to 1960, at which time they moved to Fort Dodge. From 1961 to 1980 they lived in Harlan from 1980 to 1982 Stoughton; from 1982 to 1995 Fort Atkinson, WI. He moved to Vennevoll Retirement Community in Stoughton in 1995. He was employed as a grain elevator manager in the Fort Dodge area until 1960. From that time until his retirement in 1980, he worked for the U.S. Department of Agriculture.
