## **A. Lorraine Pflugshaupt, 90**

*Nov. 29, 1911 – Feb. 12, 2002*

**ATLANTIC** – A. Lorraine Pflugshaupt, daughter of George and Stella Larimore Turk, was born Nov. 29, 1911, at Afton. She grew up in the Walnut area where she graduated from Walnut High School in 1930. She attended college at Omaha University, Cedar Falls and Drake University.

She married Elmer J. Pflugshaupt Dec. 23, 1931, at the Methodist Parsonage in Omaha, NE. The couple farmed until 1946, when they moved to their acreage in Walnut. They moved to their new home in Atlantic. She continued to live there three and one-half years after Elmer's death June 27, 1984, and then moved to 704 Cherry Street Sept. 11, 1991. She taught elementary school, many years in the Walnut and rural area, substituting for two years in Atlantic, before retiring. She was a member of Peace United Church of Christ in Walnut. She died Feb. 12, 2002, at the Cass County Memorial Hospital, Atlantic, at age 90 years.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband and one daughter, Marolyn Joy. Surviving are Lowell Turk of Atlantic; Gary, Janet and Daniel Turk of Madison, WI; sister-in-law, Florence Pflugshaupt of Walnut; a stepsister, Mildred Jacobsen of Shelby; an uncle, Virgil Turk of Avoca; nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Graveside services were held Feb. 15, 2002, at Graceland Cemetery in Avoca, with the Rev. Doris Ruben of Peace United Church of Christ in Walnut, officiating. Roland Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.
