the wagon until her father built a small home for them. A few years later, the family moved to Arkansas where Buelah continued to help in the fields and with her younger siblings.

April 12, 1940, Buelah was united in marriage to Paul Smith in Arkansas. They became parents to five children: Gordon, Paul, Jack, Diane, and Suzanne. Buelah enjoyed being a housewife and mother. After her children were older, she began working at a hospital. She later worked in a nursing home and did private patient care for twenty

Buelah and Wayne Phelps married on November 25, 1970 and lived on a farm in Rocky Comfort, MO, where they shared a love of

horses. They lived there through retirement in 1984 and in later years, moved to Neosho, MO and lived with her eldest daughter Diane. Wayne passed away in 2009 and Buelah started living with each of her daughters until the last couple of years when circumstances determined she remain with Suzanne and Larry in Defiance. It was at their residence in Defiance that she died on Sunday, June 14, 2015 having
