PERSIA - Pearl Leona (Kemmish) Plambeck, 90, of Persia was born March 2, 1911, at Persia, daughter of Charles Frederick and Mary Jane (Davis) Kemmish.

She was married June 12, 1928, to Andrew (Duke) Plambeck and they were area farmers until they retired and moved into Persia. Andrew died April 3, 1985, and Pearl lived in Persia, until entering North Crest. She was a member of the Community of Christ (RLDS) Church in Persia. She died Feb. 10, 2002, at North Crest at age 90 years.
