She spent time as a leader for the Lincoln Bluebirds 4-H Club and was able to volunteer at the hospital gift shop for a brief stint.

After moving to Harian in 1995, she was able to help with various activities in the Harlan Methodist Church until her health prevented her from doing so. It really bothered her to have to give up so many of the things she enjoyed due to her health issues. Another joy of hers was attending auctions...especially winning the bid (with several bidders). She loved spending time with her grandchildren - baking, playing games, taking them places...and shopping for them. Her time traveling with Don around the United States brought them special memories over the years. Their time in the winters in their Arizona home was enjoyable...getting away from cold, snowy lowa winters and spending time with new friends in Mesa. (However, she was always ready to get back to lowa). Margaret died at Elm Crest Retirement Home on Thursday, November 26, 2015 having attained the age of seventy-five years, six months, and twenty days.
