Two children were born to this union, Tucker and Polly. Following his retirement in 1993, Russ and Rozella enjoyed the beach and golf with new friends at Hilton Head Island, SC. He enjoyed his special time with his coffee buddies and golfer pals at the Harlan Golf & County Club and many other Harlan friends. Russ was also a life-long Nebraska Cornhusker fan. Russ died on Wednesday, January 12, 2011 at Jennie Edmundson Hospital in Council Bluffs, having attained the age of eighty-two years, two months, and twenty-nine days.
