

## Eugene Petersen, 94

July 1, 1922 - July 5, 2016

Eugene Petersen was born on July 1, 1922 to emigrant parents, Jens and Maren Petersen who came from Denmark to America in 1904. They settled on a farm in the hill country of southwestern Iowa. He attended country school, and after graduating from Harlan High School he personally trusted Christ, the Son of God as savior and Lord, whereupon the Lord called him to be a Minister of the Gospel.



During World War II he served as a Chaplain's Assistant in the 70th infantry division in three European military campaigns.

Eugene married Marjorie Harvey on June 30, 1948 in Cable, WI. They served the Lord for over one-half century in Iowa, Wisconsin, Minnesota, California, and Michigan. A graduate of the University of Minnesota and Fuller Theological Seminary. Dr. Petersen taught at San Francisco Baptist Theological Seminary and Detroit Baptist Theological Seminary.

Eugene is survived by his wife Marjorie, his son Steven, five grandchildren, and four great-grandchildren.
