Rauterkus "Shorty" was born on December 3, 1927 to Lawrence and Lucy (Kenkel) Rauterkus. He entered the Manilla Manor in June of 2014 and as his health began to deteriorate on Easter Sunday 2015, he was admitted to hospice care at Myrtue Medical Center where he peacefully left his earthly home on Tuesday, April 7, 2015 having attained the age of eighty-seven years, four months, and four days.
