Leonard and Rose Mary began their life together with the establishment of their home on a farm between Panama and Portsmouth. This was a time of great joy as the family grew to include six children. In December 1981, they moved to Harlan and the transition towards retirement in town began. Leonard and Rose Mary officially retired from farming in August 1990 which coincided with the birth of their first grandchild.

Rose Mary was a very devoted wife and loving mother and grandmother. She enjoyed reading, sewing, and quilting as well as spending time with her family. She was very active in the Catholic Church from the time she was young to her time at St. Mary's in Panama and St. Michael's in Harlan to the time of her Sacrament of the Sick she received on May 29, 2015 at Salem Lutheran Home in Elk Horn. This is where she died on June 5, 2015 having attained the age of eighty-three years,

one month and four days.
