MANNING — Michael Walter, son of Gene and Leona (Meislahri) Rohe, was born Sept. 9, 1954, in Carroll. He grew up on a farm east of Manning and attended school in Manning, where he graduated in 1972. He then attended the Nebraska School of Commerce in Omaha and farmed with his family.

June 19, 1982, Mike married Mary Margaret Dotzler at St. Peter's Catholic Church at Defiance. Four children were born to this union. Mike and Mary-have always farmed and have lived on the family farm since 1993. He was a member of Sacred Heart Church in Manning. He has been very involved with the Manning-Manilla Knights of Columbus. He died Sept. 28, 2006, at Manning Regional Healthcare Center following a courageous, nine-year battle with cancer at age 52 years and 19 days. In a final act of kindness, Mike donated his corneas so that someone else may see.
