## Dr. Richard Tollefsbol, 65

*March 12, 1939 – Sept. 7, 2004*

**ARLINGTON, TX** — Dr. Richard Glenn Tollefsbol was born in Minneapolis, MN March 12, 1939. He was a veteran of the U.S. Air Force and graduated from the University of Minnesota Dental School in 1966. He practiced dentistry in Harlan for 14 years before moving to Texas in 1980 to accept a professorship at Baylor College of Dentistry where he remained a devoted educator until his retirement in August of 2003. He served his community in De Soto, TX, as a member of the City Council, Planning and Zoning Commission and Boy Scouts of America. He shared his love of flying as a flight instructor for the Youth Program of the Civil Air Patrol. He died Sept. 7, 2004, at Medical Center of Arlington, at age 65.



He is survived by Maggie, his wife of 44 years; daughters, Tammy (David) Nadaskay, Debra Krause; sons, Greg (Tina) and Matt (Heather); and grandchildren, Jason, Lorianne, Chance, Sam and Jack.

Funeral services were held Sept. 10, 2004, at the All Saints Lutheran Church in Arlington, TX. Burial was in the Dallas-Fort Worth National Cemetery. Moore Funeral Home-Bowen Road Chapel in charge of arrangements.
