He served as mayor of Portsmouth and then on the city council, was a member of the volunteer fire department, serving as fire chief, was a member of the American Legion Post No. 547, Shelby County VFW Post No. 941, and a fourth degree member of the Knights of Columbus. At St. Mary's, he sang in the choir and served as a trustee and on the finance council.

His hobbies included bowling and enjoying the horse races; he owned greyhound racing dogs for several years and loved to play golf. Gerald died at Myrtue Medical Center in Harlan on Sunday, December 20, 2015 at the age of eighty-four years, nine months, and seven
