ELK HORN – Edith (Edie), daughter of Otis Lloyd Lewellyn and Blanche (Nellis) Cadwell, was born Jan. 3, 1912, at her home near Manilla, where she grew up and graduated from Manilla High School in 1930. She completed Normal Training and taught country school in Audubon County and at Jefferson #3 near Botna.

June 1, 1941, Edie married LeRoy Bryan Weible in Jackson, MN. Following marriage, they farmed near Welcome, MN. When they returned to Iowa, they farmed near Botna and later near Glidden, moving to Kimballton in 1965. Following Roy's death June 21, 1969, Edie moved to Elk Horn. She worked at the Elk Horn Egg Produce, drove a school bus for Elk Horn-Kimballton Community Schools and later cooked at the Danish Inn in Elk Horn and The Colonial Inn and The Villager in Walnut. She was also employed at West Central Development in Harlan where she became a resident of Westridge Apartments in 1994. Edie was a member of the United Church of Manilla. In 1998 Edie became a resident of Salem Lutheran Homes where she died Feb. 10, 2003, at age 91 years, one month and seven days.
