

HARLAN - Thomas Joseph Weis, the son of Robert Joseph and Ruth Ann (Schaben) Weis, was born on November 28, 1954, in Earling. He attended Westphalia and Defiance schools, and Harlan High School. He first ran a paper route and then worked at assisted work sites of Wesco in Denison, and later at Concerned, Inc., in Harlan, where he was employed for many years. He dearly loved his family and enjoyed spending time with them, especially at family gather-
