

Walter Wendt, 92 ✓

April 12, 1915 - July 26, 2007

OMAHA, NE — Walter Herman Wendt, son of Gustave and Marie (Noller) Wendt, was born April 12, 1915, in Avoca, and was baptized at First German Lutheran Church in Avoca. He grew up on his parents' farm and attended New Boston Township School near Avoca. Walter completed his education when he joined the United States Navy.

Walter served in the Navy for three years. After his honorable discharge, Walter returned to the Avoca area and worked on various farms around Avoca and Harlan including the farm of Wendell and Virginia Lytle near Harlan. He later moved to Omaha and began working at Omaha Livestock for over 20 years. While in Omaha, he became a member of St. Lukes Lutheran Church. He died July 26, 2007, at Omaha Nursing and Rehab in Omaha, NE, at age 92 years, three months and 14 days.

Walter is preceded in death by his parents and his three brothers, Oscar, Ernest, and Robert. He is survived by his two sisters, Laura Shephard of Bellevue, NE, and Phyllis Staub of Fountain, MN; nieces, nephews, and other relatives.
