Aug. 31, 1916 - May 17, 2004

HARLAN – Florence L. White, the daughter of Paaren and Anna Jane Mitten Fiscus, was born Aug. 31, 1916, in Redline. She attended country school at Polk Township No. 9. After school, she stayed home to help her mother and father on the farm.

April 8, 1938, Florence married James W. White at the Christian Church in Omaha, NE. To this union a daughter, Connie Jane, was born. Following their wedding, the couple farmed near Jacksonville. Florence became James' right hand after he lost his hand in a farm accident and because of her help, it enabled them to continue farming. Florence died May 17, 2004, at the University of Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha, NE, at age 87 years, eight months and 17 days.

In addition to her parents, Florence was preceded in death by her husband, James;, who died Sept. 22, 2000; brothers and sisters, Elvie Kolb, Elmer, Iliff, Melvin and Melvnee. She is survived by her daughter, Connie of Omaha, NE; her sister, LaVerne Nielsen of Harlan; brothers, Ivan Fiscus of Kirkman; Wayne Fiscus (Violet) of Kirkman; Leonard (Madge) of Harlan; nieces, nephews and other relatives.
