LINCOLN, NE – Earl LeRoy Wiese, Jr. was born to Earl Sr. and Georgia (Regenwhether) Wiese on May 18, 1948 in Clinton. Earl was an adjunct professor at DeVry University teaching quality management courses. He was a U.S. Navy Vietnam veteran.

Earl played in the band (Trenton Five) in high school as a drummer, after high school he served in the Navy from 1968-1972. Upon his return from Vietnam, Earl was active with Abate of Nebraska into the early 80's as newsletter editor. He married Julie (Greever) in 1982.

In 1986 Earl earned a degree from Doane and worked quality control for Control Data. Earl earned his master's degree from University of Phoenix in 2003 and was working on his PhD at the time of his death.
