LuElla "Tootie" Wigg, 84 ✓

HARLAN — LuElla Christine Wigg, daughter of William and Hulda (Peterson) Wigg, was born Oct. 8, 1922, on a farm near Pocohantas. She attended school there and later she and her family moved to Harlan. As an adult, "Tootie" was employed at the Harlan Produce Grocery Store and later at Concerned, Inc. She was a longtime member and active participant of the Bethel Baptist Church in Harlan. She was actively employed until she was over 72 years of age. After retirement she still continued to assist others at the Country Care Center. She made her home at the Country Care Center for over 37 years before going to Texas with her daughter in the spring of 2007. She died June 22, 2007, at the Arbrook Plaza Nursing Home in Arlington, TX at age 84 years, eight months and 13 days.

In addition to her parents, "Tootie" was preceded in death by her brothers, Barthel "Bud" Wigg and Elmer Wigg as well as her sister, Ruby Hensley. She is survived by her daughter, Linda Cox of Texas; her grandsons, Bert David Cox and Jared Michael Cox, both of Missouri; her sister-in-law, Doraine Wigg of Harlan; nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held June 25, 2007, with Pastor Walter Bowen officiating at Bethel Baptist Church.
