## **Lowell Wiley, 82**

*Nov. 8, 1921 - Nov. 9, 2003*

**NORFOLK, NE** – Lowell L. Wiley was born Nov. 8, 1921, in Shelby County, the son of Martin and Gertrude (Paulsen) Wiley. He graduated from Harlan High School in 1940. He served in the U.S. Army Air Corps during WWII from April 13, 1942 until Nov. 27, 1945. He then lived in California before returning to Harlan to farm.

He married Dolores Jacobsen Sept. 6, 1959, at Harlan. The couple then farmed near the Harlan and Elk Horn areas until 1977. He then worked for the U.S. Department of Agriculture as a meat inspector from 1977 until retiring in 1986. In 1998 the couple then moved to Norfolk, NE, and then resided at the Meadows. Lowell became a resident at the Nebraska Veterans Home in April 2003. He was a past member of the VFW Post 941 Harlan. He died Nov. 9, 2003, at the Nebraska Veterans Home in Norfolk, NE, at age 82 years and one day.

He was preceded in death by two brothers and two sisters. He is survived by his wife, Dolores of Norfolk, NE; one son, Bruce (Shelly) Wiley of Omaha; two daughters, Lisa (Tom) Calvert of Norfolk, NE and Julie (Perry) Novak of Milford, MA; and five grandchildren.

Private family funeral services were held at a later date. Home for Funerals, Norfolk, NE, in charge of arrangements.
