

**Dr. Thomas Wilson, 52****Jan. 13, 1957 - June 24, 2009**

**NEVADA** — Dr. Thomas M. Wilson, 52 of Nevada, died Wednesday, June 24, 2009 at the Israel Family Hospice House in Ames. Visitation was held from 5:30-7:30 p.m. Friday, June 26, 2009 at the Chet Ryan Mortuary in Nevada. Funeral services were held at 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 27 at the Cornerstone Church in Ames. Burial followed in the Nevada Municipal Cemetery.
