MANNING — Vivian Eloise, daughter of Evert Andrew and Gladys Elizabeth (Titzel) Eddy was born September 28, 1922 at Omaha, NE. She grew up in the Omaha area and attended North High School, graduating in 1939. After graduating Vivian worked for the U.S. Government on river dam projects. She later worked for the Federal Envelope Company in Omaha.

February 7, 1960, Vivian was united in marriage with Richard Dale Wooster at Omaha. The couple resided on Richard's family farm in Shelby County near Manning. Vivian helped on the farm and enjoyed taking care of her horses, traveling, gardening, and boating. Vivian stayed busy by always being active in her community. She was a member of Merrill's Grove Baptist Church, Pleasant Valley Neighborhood Club, Iowa Barn Association, Shelby County Historical Museum, Daughters of the American Revolution, Colonial Dames, Daughters of Founders and Patriots Association, and the Vesta Chapter of the Order of the Eastern Star. January 10, 2008, Vivian was admitted to Manning Regional Healthcare Center in Manning, IA. She died there on January 16, 2008, at the age of 85 years, 3 months, and 19 days.
