Marion Lane was a son of Lafayette M. Lane and Josephine Smith. He was a farmer in the northwest Warren Co. and Madison Co. area. He married Amanda Anna Haynes on August 21, 1898 and lived on farms in the Cumming area until they moved to Des Moines in 1930.
