The wheel broke and a piece of it struck him on the head and rendered him unconscious. He was taken to Des Moines to a hospital and lived only a few hours. The funeral was held on Sunday afternoon at the Methodist church in Cumming. Burial was at the Orilla cemetery. He leaves a wife and three small children.
